










Tick, Tick, Tick, Tick ...

The deadline for getting your program ad copy to Bob Davidson has been extended to Wednesday January 22. DON'T DELAY; the time is slipping by.



And lastly, I will be thankful for good health, a loving family, friends, and the fellowship we all share. I wish for each of you continued good health and prosperity in this New Year.










